THE BEST PLACES TO GO SKIING IN DECEMBER IN CALIFORNIA

Do you like Skiing? Not everybody knows that you can do it, even here in California! Here are some of the good and bad of the places you should check out if you feel like hitting the slopes this month.

1) MAMMOTH MOUNTAIN:

Getting there- It's less than half an hour from Mammoth-Yosemite airport, or a 5-6 hour drive from San Francisco, Los Angeles or Las Vegas.

Pros:

- Huge terrain for all ability levels.
- One of the longest seasons in the US.
- Efficient Lift System.

Cons:

- Crowded on holiday and weekends, with heavy snow.
- Expensive.
- Out of the way.

2) KIRKWOOD:

Getting there- 1.5/2 hours from Reno, Nevada 3/4 hours from the San Francisco Bay Area.

Pros:

- Exciting in-bound terrain.
- One of the highest annual snowfall averages in North America.

- Uncrowded.
- Fresh snow lasts for days.

3) HEAVENLY MOUNTAIN RESORT:

Getting there:- 1 hour drive from Reno, Nevada; 3/4 hours from San Francisco Bay Area.

Pros:

- Fifth largest Ski resort in North America.
- Great Variety of Terrain.
- Best views of Lake Tahoe, with views of the high desert on the Nevada side.

Cons:

- Can get crowded, with long lift lines.
- Not as much snow as resorts like Kirkwood and aqua valley.
